

## Concordance: DVC – LOD – Eidinow (2007)

Before the publication of DVC, É. Lhôte's edition of 167 oracular tablets from Dodona (= LOD) and E. Eidinow's catalogue of 154 inquiries were the most complete collections of oracular inquiries from Dodona in Epirus.<sup>1</sup> Both collections remain of high value, because they contain inscriptions not included in DVC (*ex negativo* the list below<sup>2</sup>), include translations, and offer in-depth commentaries on dating, language, and historical context. The following concordance is meant to facilitate the combined use of these publications for research on the oracular tablets from Dodona.

<sup>3</sup> In two cases Eidinow treats the two fragments of one inquiry as two separate inscriptions, because the inquiries were written on side A and B of a tablet broken into two halves (90, no. 4 is part of *ibid.*, no. 5; 104, no. 1 is part of 105, no. 2 = LOD 46A and 46B = C. Carapanos, *Dodone et ses ruines*, Paris 1878, pl. 38,4+35,1). Eidinow 92, no. 12, 105, no. 5 (= Carapanos (1878), pl. 40,3 = SGDI 1577a+b), and 117, no. 7 (= *BCH* 1960, 751) seem not to be included in DVC or LOD.
